Thank you for your email explaining that the Council has not yet decided on the above matter. I feel you have misinterpreted my original email and would like to assure you that there is absolutely **no intention** of 'taking over' any meeting arranged by your PC, or any other for that matter. These meetings are rightly for your own parishioners; some of whom are already on our mailing list. I have sent the same email to all other Parish Councils for the same reasons. Perhaps I should explain a little more about our organisation: -

One Voice was formed at the end of September 08 because of concerns that the general public within the New Forest had not been included in any "consultations" arranged by the NFNPA. The ensuing negative publicity about the draft plans had confusing messages which led to widespread fear amongst residents. Our organisation set out to inform the general public with facts rather than hearsay; and to empower them to lobby for public consultation meetings. (see our Mission Statement on our website). We now have 200+ members from all areas of the New Forest on our mailing list. We do not hold rallies or protest meetings - we are a quiet voice that doesn't seek publicity - we just seek the right of residents to be heard by the NPA on proposed policy issues that will affect them. Our organisation is supported by many respected NF councillors, MP's, etc., whose statements of support can be found on our website.

I hope this information is helpful and would ask if you can please keep me informed of any decisions made by your council.
