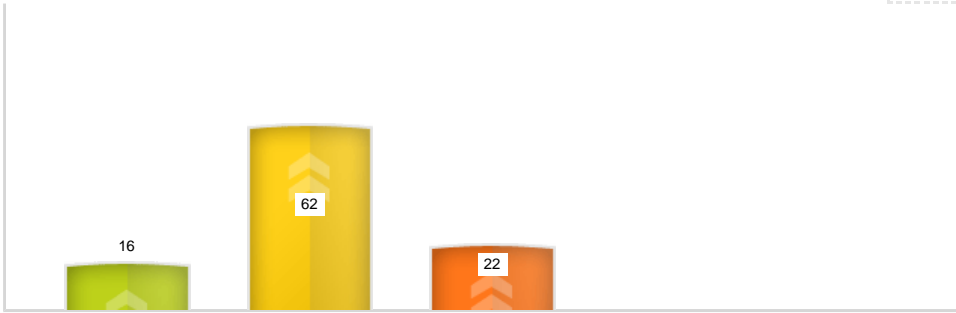


Q01: In the current economic climate National Park/Broads Authorities are good value for taxpayers money

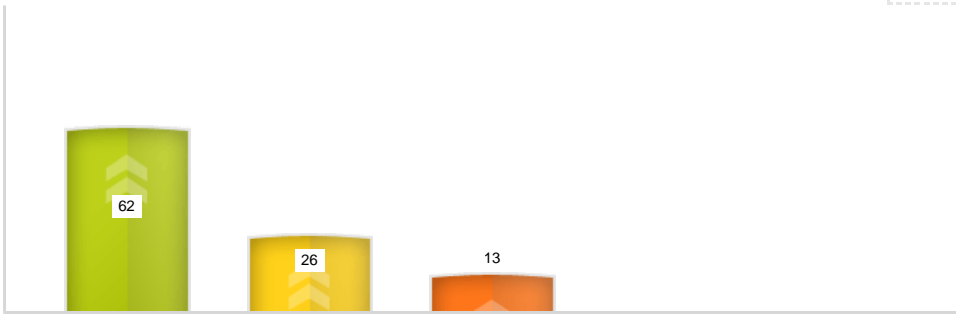

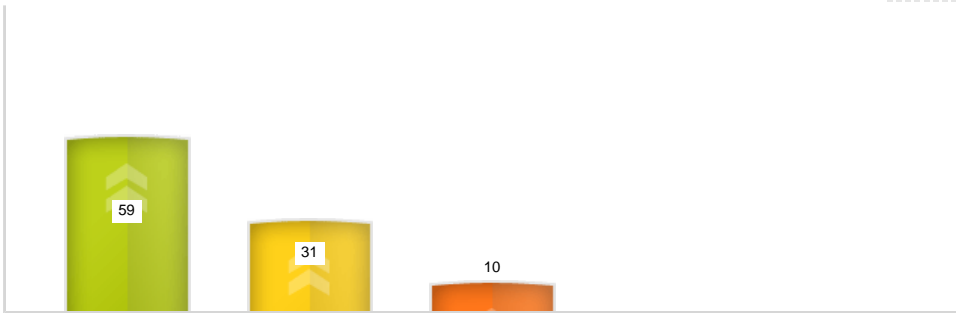

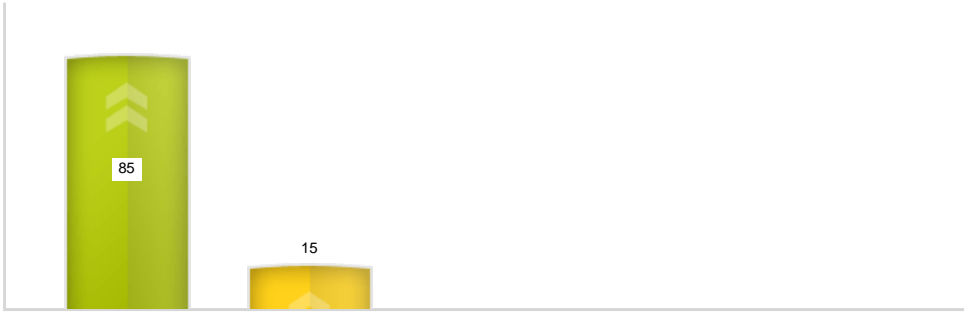

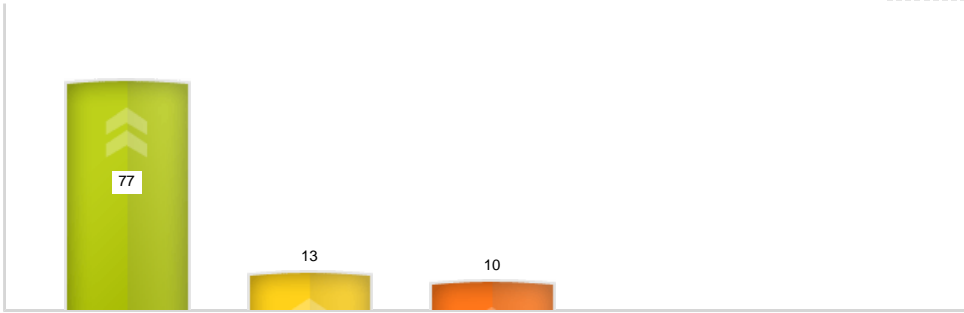

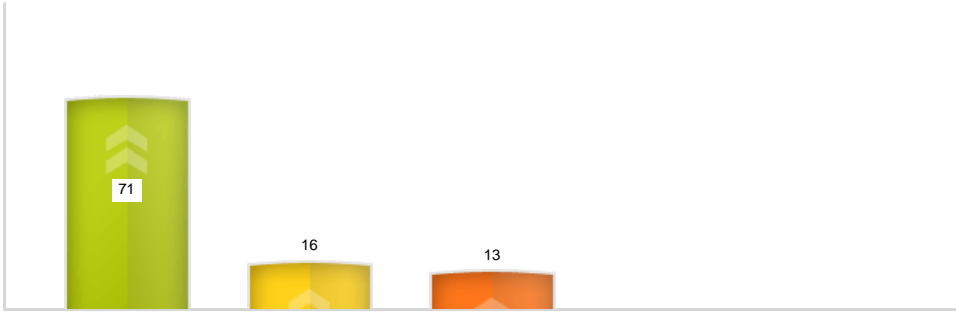

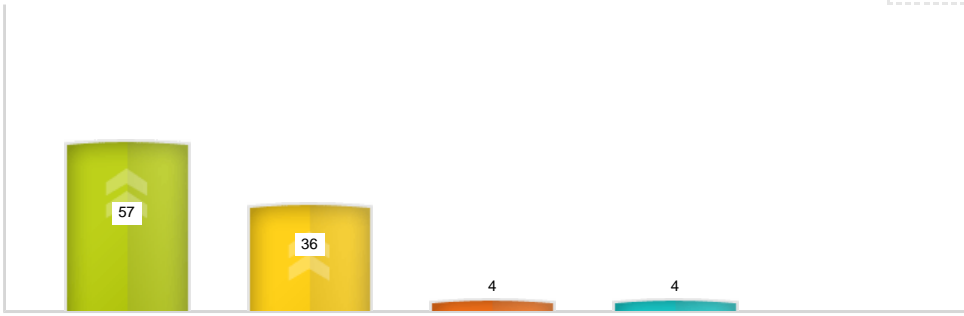

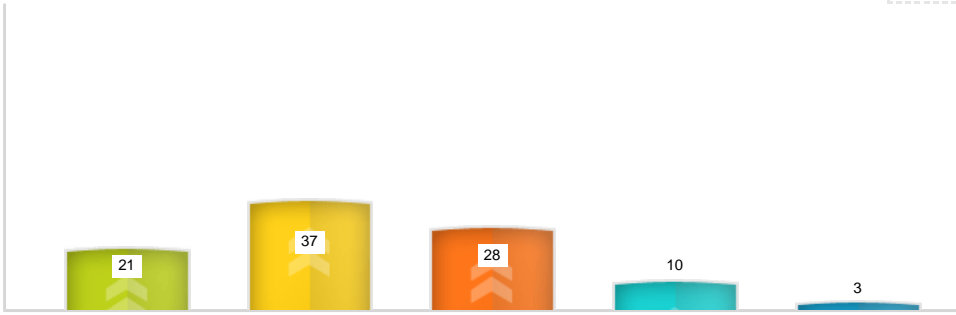

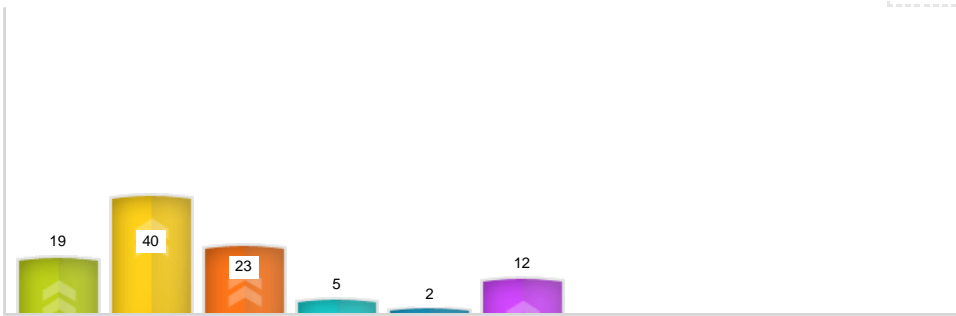

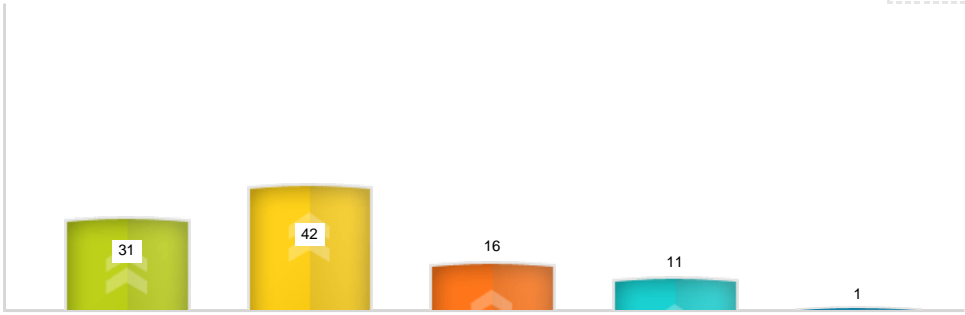

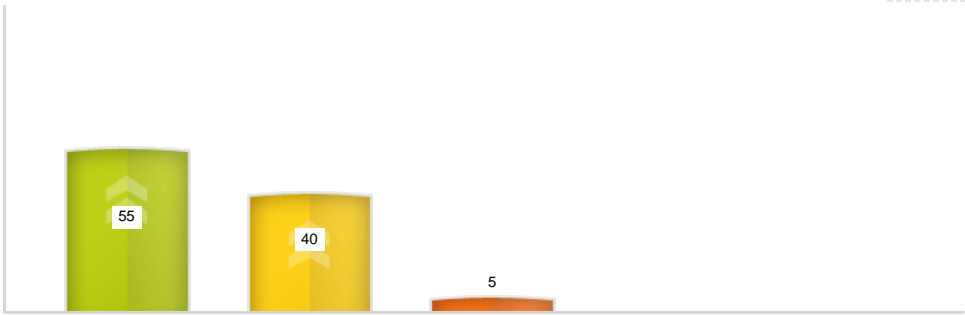

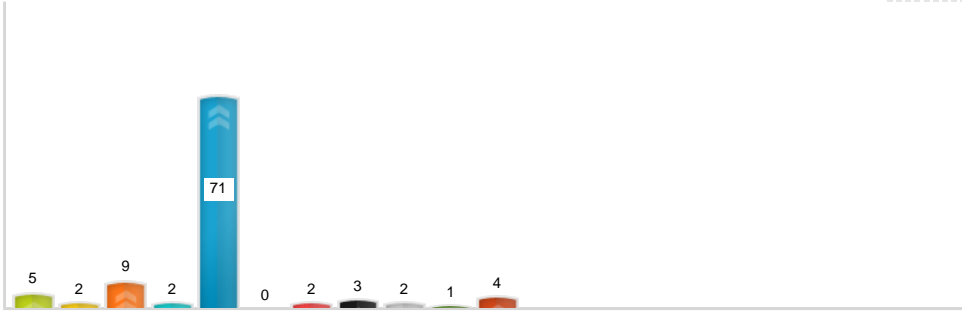

Simon stalker sue i wish to say that any governing body for the national parks should be directly elected by the people who live in them. i do not mind defra or other interested parties having representatives attached to the new forest panel perhaps to give guidance on... grants, ecological issues and efficient ways of running the forest etc.. but they are not representatives of the people living and working in the park and so are not directly accountable by them. why should only national park dwellers be the only residents in the uk being regulated by non elected people who do not live and work in the area they govern. they are clearly not accountable and do not understand how the national park runs. it is not democratic and quite unacceptable practice in the 21st century and is making the residents of the new forest national park (where i live) a living hell. my family and i have lived in the forest for over 10 years and are having to move from the forest (a place we had considered our forever home) due to the terrible way that the nffa have communicated/ publicised and now enforced the recent core strategy document with regard to planning. we (have written confirmation from the nffa) that contrary to their own policies were not notified (we do not receive park life) or warned of upcoming changes despite being in pre-application planning discussions with nffa prior to the imposition of the core strategy. the current planning regulations that are being enforced by the nffa are not what was actually written in the core strategy and as the rules are now entirely different and evolving with every new planning committee there should be a new core strategy planning consultation with all 15,000 households in nffa. i would like you to voice my particular concerns about the nffa and their recent actions regarding planning if at all possible. i am happy to prepare a more detailed explanation of what has happened to us with evidence if you think that will help. before submitting this information can we agree how it is to be presented to defra as we are still trying to resolve our planning issues direct with nffa thanks kind regards simon stalker tel 07956 675276	1

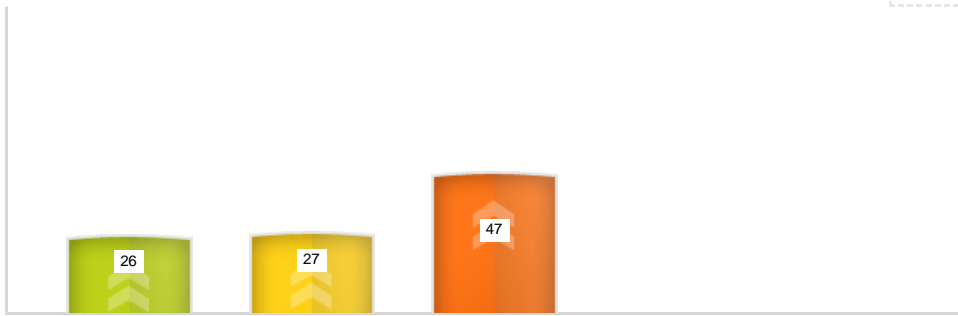
